You are now a valued member of this team because of your understanding of the importance of sustainability. You will help lead our school to become a more environmentally friendly community using your ideas and opinions.




Meetings

He even took us on a tour of our school, behind the scenes so we could see how things worked.










Recycling

We are hoping to have these signs professionally made so they will last.




Empire's Dedication to Sustainability

We would like 5 of these signs made 15" wide x 24" long to educate people on ways to be more sustainable.




Conserving Energy

We would like 50 many of these signs 4" X 3" to place next to all the light switches in our building.




Conserving Water
